Highway Department November Monthly Report:

During the month we spent several days using the excavator and backhoe to clean debris from road side ditches

Roads worked on included: Farm rd, Deer Track Lane, Sky Farm rd, Magley rd, Lakeview rd, and Leroy.

Several days were spent chipping trees and limbs that were damaged during the late October snow storms

Two men were assigned to the leave vacuum truck cleaning leaves from road side ditches and culvert pipes

One man was assigned to the tractor blowing leaves from road side ditches and culvert pipes



This blower that we use to blow leaves out of ditches and culvert pipes was adapted by Town of Copake Highway employees. It was originally a silage loader at a local farm.

Erected snow fence on Cambridge, Birch Hill, Connelly and Snyder Pond roads

Worked with Conklin Services to excavate the electrical trench and concrete pad for the new diesel tank

Pothole patched our hard surface roads
