*Continued road side mowing*

#### ***Town***

*Blew out the outside water lines at the Park and Town hall to prevent them from freezing*

*We removed several feet of the ice bars from the Town Hall roof. We also silicone and tightened all of the screws along the edge of the roof above the entrance*

***Moved the pews from storage in West Copake back to the museum***

***We picked up and returned a man lift to assist in painting the museum***

***Park***

***Our department assisted the park in setting up the Haunted House. We moved the props from storage in the West Copake fire house, as well as set up the “walls” in the park building. We spent one day in setting up and one day with the taking down and returning the props into storage.***
