2. The CHRTF campaign flyer, written by John Pollok was reviewed and revised for continued work.
3. The taskforce members were asked to contact John with a list of possible donors for the fundraising campaign as well as possible committee members for the fundraising committee.
4. There will be a groundbreaking ceremony on Mon 6/29 at 10:30am at the Rescue Squad for the CMH Rapid Care facility. All Task Force members are encouraged to attend.
5. The group discussed the Hamlet Plan after Ian Law attended the last Task Force meeting on June 10. The issue of parking was raised as a concern for businesses in the hamlet. Roberta will ask Margaret Irwin to come to speak with area business owners in late July or early August. There were positive comments from the community on the streetscape plans.
6. Jeff Nayer and Roberta will meet with Dean Knox, Columbia County Engineer for the DOT to discuss funding ideas for streetscape project.
7. The idea of creating a fund for planning projects was discussed.
8. Bike Copake is hoping to have a new brochure published by early July, including some new routes. The Bike Maintenance and Safety Program on June 6 at the Roe Jan Library was well attended.
9. There was no discussion of the Grange film series at the last Grange meeting due to low attendance.
