### **Minutes:**

## **Grants**

- Kathy Marchione's Director of Governmental Affairs, Ken Girardin, told Chris that no grants were available right now. Ken will pursue grant opportunities again in January.
- Didi Barrett recommended that we contact the Dyson Foundation, and the Berkshire Taconic Foundation specifically about their Donor Advised Funds, for hamlet plan funding. Nancy will follow up.
- We will plan on reapplying to the First Niagara Foundation in January 2014 for the hamlet plan.
   Nancy is awaiting more feedback from Regional Grant Representative Kelly Fishbach. Nancy will contact Kelly again.
- We should plan on asking for funds from the NYS Regional Economic Foundation grant program in
  June. This look like a great opportunity to help businesses trying to open in Copake. Consider for the
  Copake Inn or JJ's. Nancy will research more.
- Since we are sometimes required to solicit funds through a not-for-profit, Nancy suggested that we could enhance the image of Copake Community Service Inc. for grant makers by:
  - Putting some CCS money in 1<sup>st</sup> Niagara Bank
  - Creating a web site
  - Having the web site receive on-line donations
  - Getting a debit or credit card for paying for web site expenses, etc.

Rus has no objection to the web site. Who is going to be charge of designing and maintaining it? How will CCS pay for it pay for it?

# **Didi Barrett Meeting**

- Seek information about the Berkshire Taconic 'donor directed' program.<sup>1</sup>
- Contact the Dyson Foundation. We can use Didi Barrett's name.
- Continue to pursue the ESD Regional Economic Development Council funding opportunities.

- Research the OMEGA waste water disposal system. Roberta will follow up.
- Focus on shorter term ventures to revitalize the hamlet.

- Pursue the Chatham Brewery. Also consider a cidery.

- Consider reaching out to Sharon Hospital for Rapid Care in Copake.
- Keep trying to get federal historic preservation status for Copake Hamlet.
- We should talk to Ken Flood. Roberta is trying to schedule Ken to come and meet with us (maybe Dec. 11)
- Nick Melson, Didi's Chief of Staff, advised that our infrastructure plans may impact the timing for the hamlet road reconstruction. They may not want to surface the road until the infrastructure warranty runs out.
