Highway Department July 2013 Monthly Report:

Pothole patched for one day

Repaired washouts on Empire and Chrysler Pond roads

Replaced 200 feet of culvert pipes on Van de Carr road

Installed a catch basin and 85 feet of culvert pipe on Craryville road

We continued road side mowing; this will continue into the fall

Started blacktop drag boxing; roads that we worked on were: Odyssey Farm North, Old 22, Breezy Hill and North Mountain roads

Spent one day chipping downed tree limbs following a heavy wind/rain storm

As part of the Office of General Services salt contract, we were required to take delivery of last season's salt reservation. With the salt that we had delivered we have started filling the sand building in anticipation of this upcoming winter.

Hauled sand to our stockpile

Inter-departmental assistance the Highway Department provided:

Town:

We put up and took down the hamlet American Flags for the 4th of July

Painted the conference room, the Town Clerks office and the halls in the Town Hall

We power washed the exterior of the Town Hall

Installed the Welcome to Copake Falls signs

Changed the Town Hall water filter

Worked with Busy Beaver tree service to remove two large trees overhanging the Museum

Park:

Replaced the shingles on the pavilion roof that had blown off during a recent wind storm

Transported a water sample from the Park to the lab in Albany for testing

Changed the Park Building water filter

Copake Fire Company:

Worked on the fuel system on 14-2 after it would not start

Inter-municipal Cooperation provided:

We used Ancram's water truck to flush out several culvert pipes

We provided a truck to haul gravel for several days

They used our blacktop roller

They supplied a blacktop paver, two operators and two trucks to help us start paving on North Mountain Road
