Highway Department June 2013 Monthly Report:

Following the numerous thunderstorms that occurred during the month of June we replaced/upgraded over 390 feet of culvert pipes. Roads that we worked on included: Valley View and High Valley.

We continued the annual cleaning of the ditches on our dirt roads. After the ditches are cleaned of debris and reshaped to carry rain runoff, we grade, gravel and apply liquid calcium to the road surface.
