## ***Highway Department January 2017 Monthly Report:***

*Snow and Ice Control was the primary duty for the past month. During the month of January our full crew conducted snow and ice removal operations on 9 separate days. There were several nights or mornings that I was able to salt isolated slippery spots with the town pickup sander. The pickup truck sander allows me to treat these isolated spots faster than calling in crews; additionally it minimizes wear and tear on the large trucks.*

*Between snow/ice storms we continued to clean, inspect and repair our equipment. All routine maintenance and nearly all equipment repairs are done in house.*

*Spent several days mixing sand and salt for use during snow storms*

*Pothole patched on one day*
