Highway Department June 2017 Monthly Report:

We have completed this year's oil and stone operations. This process, also known as Chip Sealing, involves the application of a layer of asphalt emulsion that is then covered by a layer of stone aggregate. The oil seals and protects the existing layer of pavement. Once embedded the , provides a thin wearing course for vehicular traffic. The roads sealed this year were: Weed Mine, Empire, Farm, Snyder Pond, Mountain View, Yonderview Roads as well as Taconic St and the driveway into the Town Park

Cleaned the ditches and culverts on: Camphill, Wanzell, Skytop, Leroy and Spring Roads

Graded then spread gravel and calcium on: Rail Road, Cambridge, Fidance, and Sky Farm roads

We continued road side mowing

We hauled road materials from Greenport to the Highway Garage stockpile in anticipation of summer road work

The Highway Crew participated in the OSHA training provided by the Columbia County Highway Superintendents Association

Inter-departmental assistance the Highway Department provided:

Park

Repaired two park benches

Pulled and reset several signs

Replaced several split rail fence posts

Sealed the driveway leading into the Park

Moved the Summer Program box and supplies from storage in West Copake back to the Park

We cut brush and limbs around the West Copake Firehouse
