## ***Highway Department May 2017 Monthly Report:***

### ***Graded Lakawanna and Valley View roads***

*This past month we continued this year's drag box operations. We finished Snyder Pond, Mountain View, Farm and Yonderview Roads. We also repaired the driveway into the Park.*

### ***We began road side mowing***

*We hauled road materials from Greenport to the Highway Garage stockpile in anticipation of summer road work*

*On May 20th we held our annual Copake Cleanup day. We collected 14 ten-wheeler loads of trash weighing a total of 16.78 tons. All this rubbish was disposed of at Carmen Barbato, Inc. The 100 tires collected were disposed of at the Columbia County Waste Department. We sorted out the used electronics during cleanup day. We saved 8 pallets of TV's, computers, printers, etc. from ending up in a landfill. These electronics were recycled through CORARC Ecycle. Town Clerk Larry Proper and Town Supervisor Jeff Nayer assisted the Highway Department. The park maintenance department also sent one employee to assist us.*
